In Milan the Saloni Return: and the Fair Becomes Event

From 14th to 19th April 2010 Milan Fairground hosts the 49th edition of Salone Internazionale del Mobile along with Eurocucina, the International Bathroom Furniture Exhibition, the International Furnishing Accessories Exhibition and SaloneSatellite

s always, next April the Fieramilano fairgroundsin Rho will play host to the Saloni, from 14th to 19th, and the countless range of goods on offer – from furniture to furnishing accessories, from kitchens to bathrooms to pieces by young designers – all bristling with quality and originality, combined with an innovative layout that will prove even more joined up and userfriendly.

The Event is back, as the publicity campaign for the next edition of the Saloni declares, making a magnificent return after the last record edition which was attended by 313,385 visitors – operators, general public and the press amongst them – a fitting tribute to the quality of the commercial offering and to the exhibition organisation.

The Saloni 2010 are therefore gearing up, as always, with their characteristic great confidence and boundless optimism, buoyed up by the fact that the level of exhibitor interest has been such that all the space is now entirely sold out.

The shows in the Show

Next April over 2300 exhibitors will set out their wares over an exhibition space in excess of 210,000 m² at the Milan fairgrounds, where the 49th Salone Internazionale del Mobile is to be held, with Eurocucina (the International Kitchen Furniture Exhibition), the International Bathroom Furniture Exhibition, the International Furnishing Accessories Exhibition and SaloneSatellite.

This year the biennial Kitchen Furniture Exhibition along with FTK (Technology for the Kitchen), the event dedicated to technological innovation in built-in electrical appliances and cooker hoods, will occupy four pavilions, while two other pavilions, will be given over to the Bathroom Furniture Exhibition.

The decision to pack the Salone Internazionale del Mobile, which will be showing the Modern section in its entirety, into one of the two two-storey buildings (Pavilions 14-16 and 18-20) directly adjacent to the other sectoral Pavilions, thus creating a single throughway, was made on functional grounds.
